<b>Entry Fee</b>	<b>£5 PER CLASS</b> entries – to be in no later than <b>24th August</b> Show Jumping and Pony games can be paid for on the day
<b>Prize Money</b>	<b>1<sup>st</sup> £10 2<sup>nd</sup> £7 3<sup>rd</sup> £5 4<sup>th</sup> £3</b> for all classes unless otherwise stated and providing sufficient entries in each class 1 <sup>st</sup> place money can be collected at the end of the day once judging has finished.
<b>Trophies</b>	The Champion from each group will receive a Rosette and in some cases a Trophy too.
<b>Rules</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. All horses and ponies must be passported and in 12 months of having their vaccinations.</li> <li>2. Strictly NO entries on the day except Show Jumping and Pony Club Games.</li> <li>3. Any entry may be refused if the judge believes the animal to be lame or in poor physical state.</li> <li>4. Whips and spurs may not be used in the Pony Games, spurs also not allowed in pony ring.</li> <li>5. Excessive use of the whip or spurs, mistreating a horse or rider in a dangerous manner will be severely penalised.</li> <li>6. Riders must wear the correct apparel on horseback, riding hats must conform to current safety standards and use of a protector is strongly recommended.</li> <li>7. Riders competing in Lead Rein classes are not eligible for Non-Lead Rein classes.</li> <li>8. Animals under the age of 4 years must not be ridden on the show field.</li> <li>9. The showing classes are divided into groups, the Champion and Reserve from each group are eligible to compete for Supreme Champion at the end of the day.</li> <li>10. Times printed in the Schedule are approximate and dependent on the number of entries which is unknown at the time of going to print.</li> </ol>
