General Rules for Horse & Pony Events

- Strictly no entries on the day except for clear round show jumping.
- All entries should be made to the section leader using the specific entry form for Horse & Pony classes. An entry may be refused if the judge believes the animal to be lame, or in a poor physical state.
- Whips and spurs must not be used in the pony games.
- Excessive use of the whip or spurs, mistreating a horse, or riding in a dangerous manner will be severely penalised.
- Riders must wear the correct apparel on horseback.
- Riding hats must conform to current safety standards and the use of a body protector is strongly recommended.
- Riders competing in lead-rein classes are not eligible for non-lead-rein classes.
- Animals under the age of 4 years must not be ridden on the show field. The showing classes are divided into groups, the champion and reserve from each group are eligible to compete for the best in show award at the end of the day. Times printed in the schedule are approximate and are dependent on the number of entries.
